## **Festival Application Rules**

**LOCATION:** This an outdoor event located at Postell Park (530 Beachview Drive) in the Pier Village of St. Simons Island, Georgia.

**ART:** All pieces must be hand crafted by the artist. Resale or wholesale items (buy/sell) are not permitted and will result in immediate dismissal without refund. No manufactured, imported items or raw materials will be allowed. Artists may only show and sell work form the category in which they have been accepted. This is a family orientated show. Any work deemed unsuitable by the jury committee will be removed from the show. No refund will be given.

**ARTIST:** The artist must arrive on time and stay for the duration of the festival. Artists may not open their booth late or close early. No agents, dealers, or representative may attend in place of the artist. Only the artist may display in a booth unless the work produced is a collaboration of two artists. Only partners in business signing all work with one name may exhibit together.

**SET UP/BREAKDOWN:** Set-up times for each festival will be mailed out with acceptance letters. Show hours are 10 am to 5 pm Saturday and Sunday. No one is to break down or to remove any part of his/her exhibit before 5 pm on Sunday. Vehicles are not permitted in the festival area during the festival hours.

**PARKING:** Artist must park in the designated parking area with the exception of set up and tear down.

**SALES:** Artists are solely responsible for collecting, reporting and submitting payment to the Georgia Department of Revenue, Sales and Use Tax Division.

**REFUNDS:** The application form and registration fee constitute a commitment to show. No refunds will be issued once acceptance notification letters have been mailed. Those applications not accepted will receive their photos and booth fee check in the mail.

**BOOTH SPACE:** A 12 ft x 12 ft space allows for a 10 ft x 10 ft tent. Artists must furnish their own tent, display tables, skirting, & chairs. All displays must be designed, constructed, and operated in good taste. All displays, sales and promotional activities must be confined to artist's assigned space. Portable generators or drop cords across the walkway are not permitted. If you have a canopy, extended tent stakes, or side displays, you will need to pay for two spaces. A portion of the park can only handle weights due to underground sprinkler system. Let us know if you must use stakes. Preferences for artist booth location will be given consideration according to postmarked date of application and to media exhibited. We cannot guarantee a specific booth space but will try for the general area requested.

**SECURITY:** Management provides nominal after hour security for the festival with the understanding that Glynn Art Association, Glynn County or the festival show coordinator will not assume any liability for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

**CATEGORIES:** Please be specific when completing your application.

**FINE ARTS/GRAPHICS:** Acrylic, Oil, Watercolor, Pastel, Charcoal, Pencil, Pen & Ink, Printmaking, Mixed Media, Photography

**FINE CRAFTS:** Glass, Jewelry (be specific), Leather, Metal, Pottery/Sculpture, Wood, Textiles, Fiber, Baskets, Wearable Art
